Paragraph 9.3. Welfare The Regional Animal Welfare Units shall be responsible for the implementation and dissemination of all information relating to animal welfare practices, issues, and concerns. They shall be responsible for developing, administering, and maintaining welfare program and monitoring system in their area of jurisdiction. In addition, they shall be responsible for the welfare of animals in the industry (BAI), Regional Units, 2) Provincial or municipal government, and 3) other government agencies.
